1. Setting Up Noptin for Your Tea Blog

- Install Noptin from WordPress Plugins → Add New and activate it.
- Configure sender name and email in Noptin → Settings.
- Install WP Mail SMTP and connect to SendGrid, Mailgun, or Amazon SES.
- Create a subscription form with Email and First Name fields.
- Embed forms in blog posts, sidebar widgets, and footer areas.
- Enable popup forms triggered by time on page or scroll depth.

2. High Engagement Tea Newsletter Structure

- Personal intro story about a tea you recently tried.
- Tea of the Week review with origin and tasting notes.
- Brewing tip explaining temperature and steeping time.
- Tea discovery such as history, farming, or processing.
- Links to new blog posts or reviews.
- Community question inviting readers to reply.

3. Email Automations Blueprint

Welcome Sequence:

- Email 1: Welcome email with links to your best tea guides.
- Email 2: Share your favorite teas and recommendations.
- Email 3: Brewing tips and links to helpful tutorials.

Blog Post Automation:

- Trigger emails whenever a new blog post is published.
- Filter by tea-related categories such as reviews or brewing guides.

Monthly Newsletter:

- Curate your best tea discoveries and blog posts.
- Highlight one featured tea each month.
